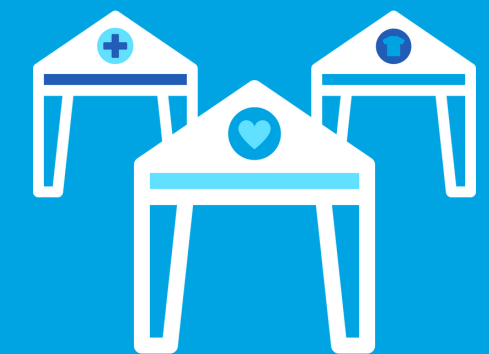

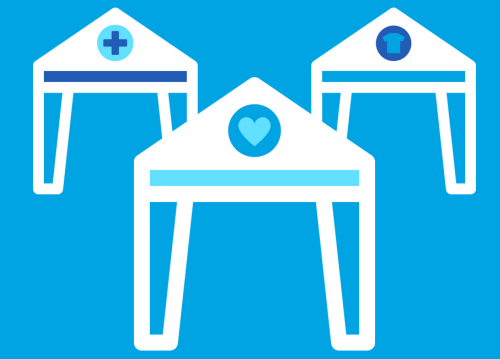

In total, we served **203 individuals** with services such as showers, haircuts, housing aid, legal aid, medical, food and beverage, and more.



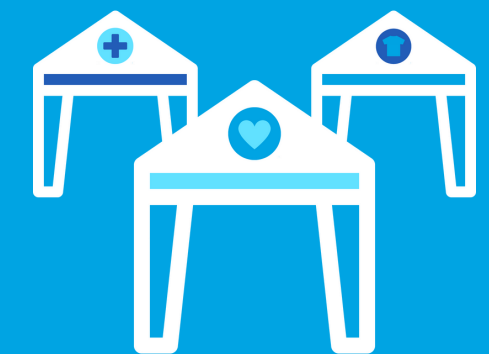

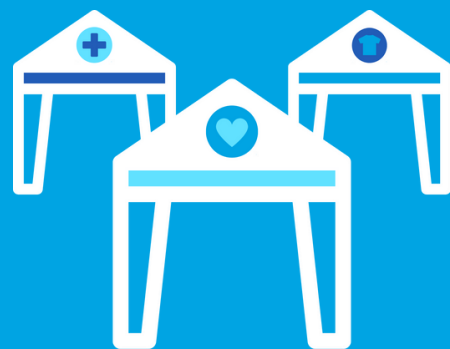
